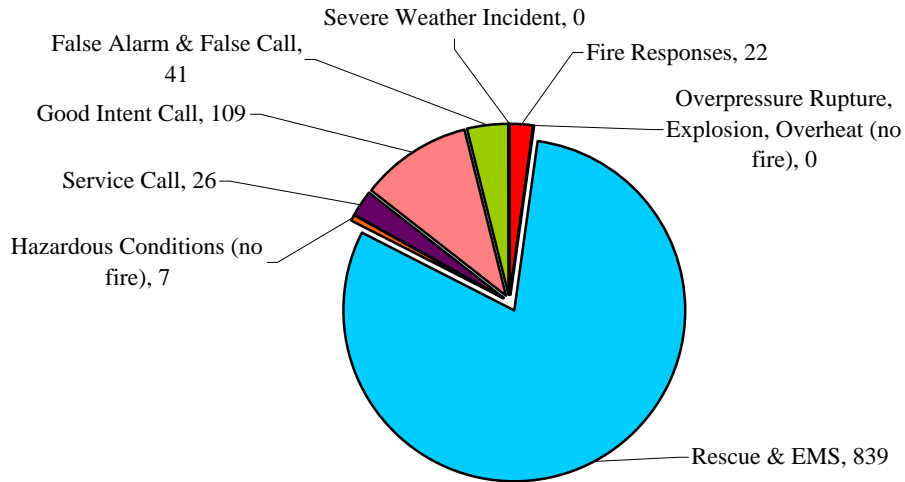

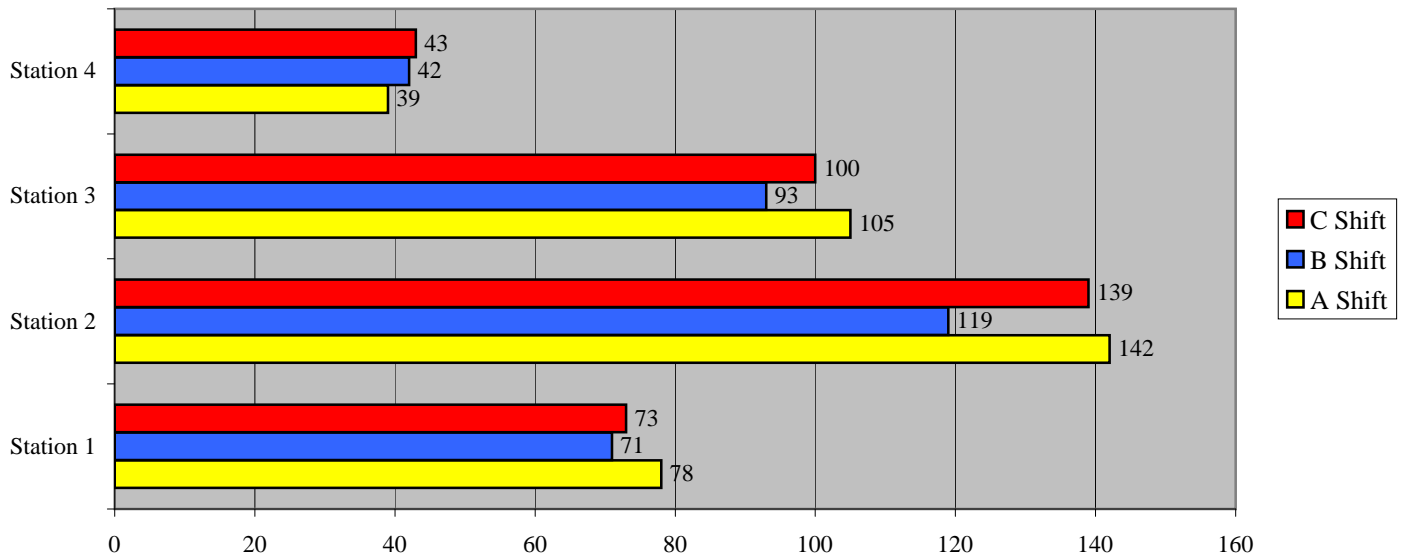

Alarm Responses (January-March 2009)

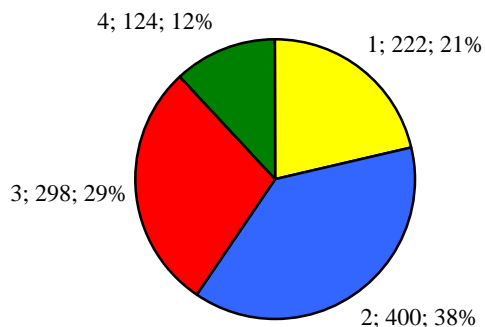
