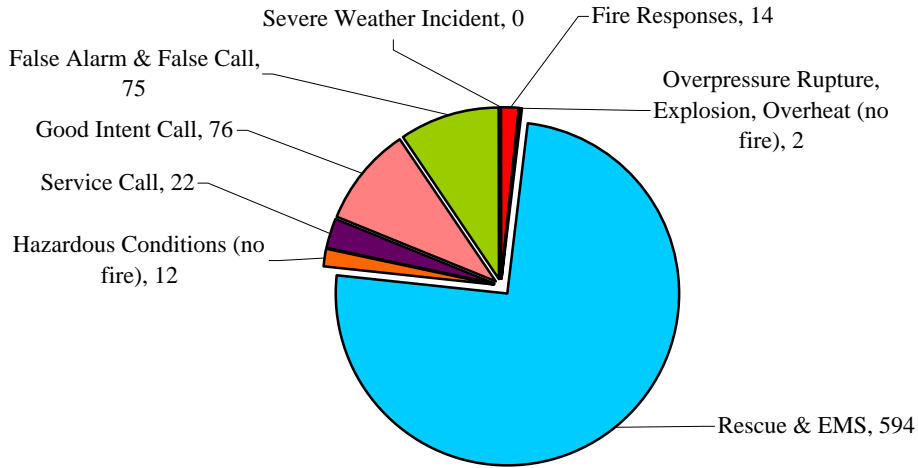

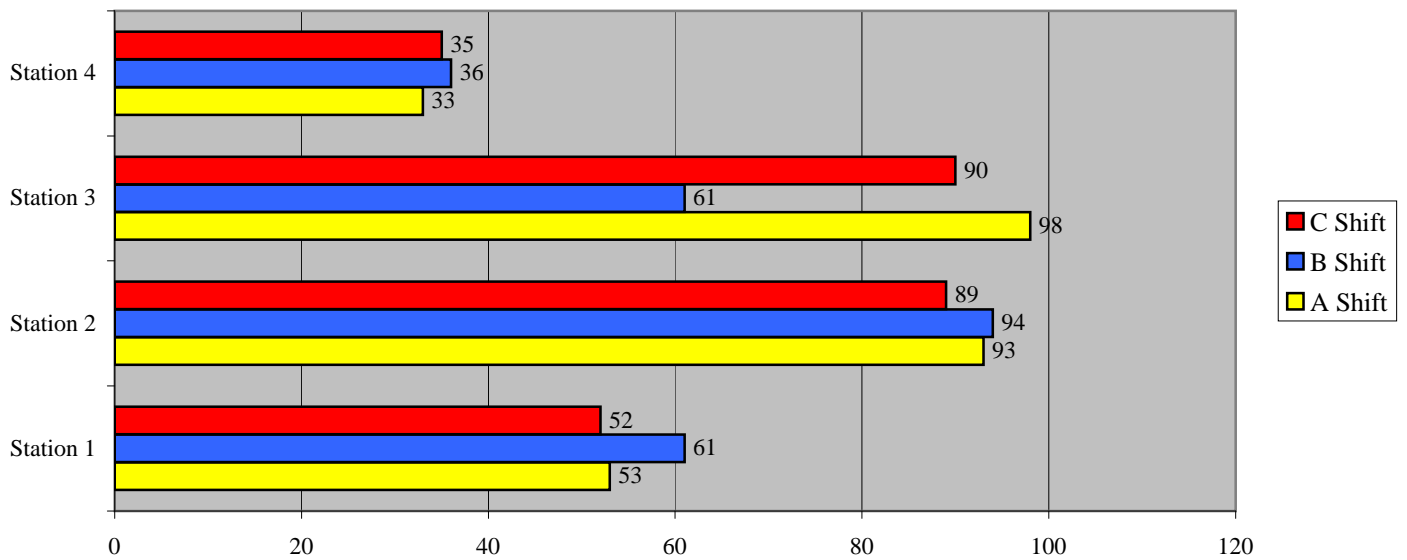

Alarm Responses (October - December 2008)

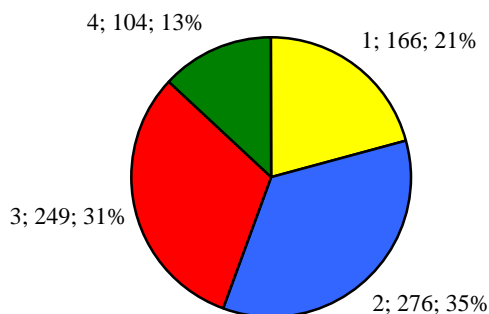
