- 4. **ACTION REQUESTED** Authorize the purchase of a portable radio repeater for \$15,575.20. **WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY** Board action is required for purchases above \$10,000.00. **WHAT THE ACTION ACCOMPLISHES** Procures a portable radio repeater for disasters and building signal strength testing.
